Principal's Report (6:45pm) - Rosa Fong

- First two weeks of school went well
- She is still working of staff support including getting a permanent librarian. We will receive an update about this at Back to School Night.
- Her office is always open to parents. If she is busy, please see Ms. Shellie to schedule an appointment.
- Q: What is she most excited about for this year? A: Having a part-time IT person and a full-time mental health/social worker. Also, Rosa is still focused on community building at Alamo.
- Q: Status of librarian? A: Alamo is not ID'd as a needy school. The SFUSD is short on librarians. We are budgeted to have a 3-day a week librarian but we currently have 2 1-day a week librarians. She is working on it as best she can. If the PTA wanted to consider funding this need, Rosa would be open to discussing.

Foundation Update (7:02pm) – Elizabeth Meeks

- Explanation of Friends of Alamo School Foundation: This was started years ago because Alamo families wanted to hire specialists/consultants to provide additional enrichment programs to our students. Currently, the foundation funds Ms. Kat (singing and chorus), Ms. Murphy (PE), Jodie Louie (Literacy), ceramics supplies, a portion of Education Outside, field trips and Coffee & Conversation.
- Update: Last years auction grossed 54k (net 37k). Raffle grossed almost 38k (net 33k).
- To ensure the quality of our employees/consultants, each year, the Foundation has teachers fill-out a survey to review the 3 employees. The results from last years survey were they all received wonderful reviews.

Communications (7:07pm) - Tal Palter

- Tal has been on communications team for 3 years.
- Goal: To communicate Alamo happenings to staff, teachers, families.
